

## **DC Snowpark Kitzbühel**

**Since the premiere season in winter 08/09 the DC Snowpark Kitzbühel gleams in renewed splendor again and again and therefore is magnet for all snow-hungry freestylers. For the upcoming season the QParkdesigners thought about some new specials that will raises the snowpark to the next level!**

The DC Snowpark Kitzbühel can be reached easily via the comfortable gondola from Mittersill. After a short ride you reach the chair-lift at the Hanglalm, bringing you up to the top. From the bird's-eye perspective, one can notice the perfect arrangement of the lines, combinations and units straight away. Besides the classic kicker- and rail-lines on all levels, you can enjoy some sensational runs through the wooden park involving some up-down boxes, picnic-tables and tree-jibs.

Not enough with that a totally new park area has been built up in the last season, that connects the upper and lower part and hosts several beginner- and medium obstacles for more jib pleasure. Only constant changes care for challenge and action in a freestyle playground, that's why the shape team around Franz Lechner came up with a massive speciality in the past winter. The huge gapjump not only attracted many pros and filmcrews, but also made the local riders happy.

The set-up is upgraded with every season and so also the DC Snowpark Kitzbühel gets further obstacles inviting to shred and chill. In particular the advanced riders can freak out and perfectionate their skills at the new kink rail mystic and the straight box. A jibcan, a 9m curved box and a 9m downrail is added to the proline. Not for nothing the snowpark at the Hanglalm is known as freestyle mekka.

Into the bargain, the Kitzbüheler Horn presents an absolute must for freeriders. From easy powder lines to some trickier areas, up to real big-mountain-riding including fat gutters, large cliffs and steep faces, everything is possible. Even though the resort has a large backcountry, most of it is easy accessible and even the hikes to the most beautiful runs are not too exhaustive. Among other spots, on the Hahnenkamm apart from mass tourism and rolled ski runways, you can pull wonderful sprays or mount some electrifying kickers with your friends. At the bottom line there's just to say: Come, see and ride!

### **Local tip: Stephan Wimmer**

*"I've been riding the Resterhöhe for years, for it is one of the sparse areas of the region where you can have some awesome powderrides also in bad weather conditions, for there are many half-open forest sections. If the wheather's right, you can find various kicker-lines and corner-spots. Inside the park I adore the 3-lane kickerline, as it's one of the few where you can practice some new tricks and styles. Moreover, the kickers are extremely smooth and safe, yet providing plenty airtime to make nice airs possible."*
